
Addendum to the Texti AI Mobility Inc. Platform Access Agreement

Newfoundland and Labrador | Effective August 4, 2026 | Version 1.3

This Addendum supplements the Texti AI Mobility Inc. Platform Access Agreement for Drivers providing Rides in Newfoundland and Labrador. If it conflicts with the Agreement, this Addendum prevails for Rides in the province. Capitalized terms have the meanings in the Agreement.

1. Territory and authorization

The initial intended service area is St. John's and the surrounding metropolitan area, including Mount Pearl and Paradise. The live Territory is the area shown by the Platform and authorized under Texti AI Mobility Inc.'s then-current Transportation Network Company approvals. No Driver may accept a dispatch outside that authorized Territory.

2. Driver licensing

- Hold a valid Newfoundland and Labrador **Class 4 driver's licence or higher**, without a condition, restriction, prohibition, or court order that prevents ride-sharing work.
- Carry your licence whenever online and immediately report a suspension, downgrade, restriction, prohibition, or material demerit action.
- Consent to the lawful collection and disclosure of the driver's licence information required by the Motor Registration Division.

3. Minimum age

Drivers must be at least twenty-one (21) years old under Texti AI Mobility Inc.'s eligibility policy.

4. Vehicle requirements

- Registered in Newfoundland and Labrador and exactly matching the approved vehicle shown in your Texti AI Mobility Inc. profile.
- No more than ten (10) model years old, calculated against the current calendar year, with at least four doors and functioning seat belts for every seating position.
- Covered by a current annual inspection completed by an Official Inspection Station authorized for the vehicle class.
- Maintained in safe, clean, roadworthy condition and displaying every decal or identifier required by the company and applicable law while offering rides.

5. Insurance

Maintain insurance for the approved vehicle that meets the Highway Traffic Act and applicable insurance regulations, including coverage for paid passenger and ride-sharing use. Personal-use-only coverage is not sufficient. Texti AI Mobility Inc. may suspend or revoke Driver Mode whenever coverage cannot be verified.

6. Screening and continuing eligibility

Before activation, complete identity verification and a certified criminal record check satisfactory to the Registrar, obtained from the RNC, RCMP, or another organization accepted under applicable law. A provider status does not activate Driver Mode by itself. Texti AI Mobility Inc. performs final human review of the screening outcome, Class 4 licence, work eligibility, profile photo, registration, insurance, and inspection. Report any later event that could make you ineligible.

7. Trip operation and records

- Accept and perform Rides only through Texti AI Mobility Inc.'s transportation network; street hails and off-Platform arrangements are prohibited.
- Keep GPS location permission active while online and during a Ride so the Platform can record the vehicle's location and route and provide legally required live trip sharing.
- Use only the approved Driver identity and vehicle disclosed to the rider. Never substitute another person or vehicle.
- Do not begin the trip until the Platform has delivered the driver and vehicle disclosure and the rider has accepted the vehicle.

8. Municipal and provincial rules

Comply with the Highway Traffic Act, Transportation Network Company Regulations, applicable municipal rules, and every term of the company's licence. Texti AI Mobility Inc. may immediately disable Driver Mode where a driver or vehicle no longer satisfies those requirements.

9. Taxes

Newfoundland and Labrador participates in the HST. Texti AI Mobility Inc. handles HST on the passenger-facing Fare as merchant of record. The Driver's separate supply of contractor services to Texti AI Mobility Inc. may carry its own income-tax and GST/HST obligations. Confirm those obligations with the Canada Revenue Agency or a qualified tax professional and provide any required registration information.

10. Governing law

The Agreement and this Addendum are governed by the laws of Newfoundland and Labrador and the federal laws of Canada applicable there. Subject to mandatory rights, disputes are heard by the courts sitting in St. John's, Newfoundland and Labrador.
